- Unless Special Arrangements are made, stallions must be available from February 1st to June 1st and in residence at EAH until all booked mares have been bred.
- EAH will collect all breeding fees before any breedings will be honored unless other arrangements have been made.
- EAH will only retain the \$250 booking fee and will at the stallion owners discretion either forward the collected funds to the stallion owner or apply the funds to the stallion owners account at Emery Animal Health.
- Stallion owner shall also receive a \$50credit per mare booked to their stallion to go towards their account at Emery Animal Health.
- Board: Each stallion will be provided a stall as is appropriate and designated by the stallion owner or upon an individually negotiated basis. EAH feeds high quality alfalfa hay and can usually provide any supplement the stallion owner requests their stallion be provided in cost of board.
- Any necessary vet care, vaccinations, farrier services, etc., are at the stallion owner's expense and will be billed directly to the stallion owner.
- Exercise: each stallion will be turned out regularly as is appropriate or upon an individually negotiated schedule as suggested by the stallion owner.
- Promotion: Each stallion will be advertise on Emery Animal Health's website and actively promoted by the staff of EAH when contacted or visited by potential clients. Postage, stationery, use of miscellaneous office products regarding stallion promotion and/or returning long distance phone calls responding to client inquiries will be provided by EAH. Any additional advertising, such as magazine ads or similar promotions, is at the stallion owner's expense.
- Several promotional packages are available upon request.

- Presentation: Subject to schedules and appointments, each stallion shall be professionally presented to all interested clients upon their arrival to view the stallion.
- Stallion Owners will bear no expense associated with semen collection, evaluation, insemination, or shipment of cooled or frozen semen. EAH will collect and retain these fees from the mare owners who purchase breedings.

All due diligence and personal supervision is exercised in taking quality care of on-premise horses by EAH owners, employees, and their agents, but said individuals cannot be held responsible or liable for any disease, accident, injury, or death of client animals or damage to cryopreserved samples while in the custodial care of Emery Animal Health.
